Kananaskis Country Campgrounds operates numerous provincial campgrounds and three camper stores, located throughout 5 valleys of Kananaskis Country, in the Rocky Mountains of Alberta. We are seeking highly motivated, hard working individuals to fill summer staffing positions. Perfect for outdoor enthusiasts wanting to spend the summer in the Rocky Mountains! Make the most out your summer by using your time off to explore the endless opportunities to hike, bike, scramble, climb, paddle, and camp in some of the most incredible terrain Alberta has to offer.

Job Responsibilities: Our store centre in Peter Lougheed Provincial Park is a busy location that houses our campers' store and popular ice cream window. This is also where we handle camper registration and information. The retail clerk would be responsible for a wide variety of duties that may include retail sales of food products and camping supplies, campground registrations, answering phone inquiries, serving scooped ice cream, providing visitors with information about the park and campgrounds, stocking shelves, cash handling, store opening and closing, store & washroom cleaning, and other duties as assigned.

Skills: We are seeking friendly and upbeat people with strong communication, time management, and customer service skills. We want our customers and guests to feel welcome and get the most out of their visit to the park. We are seeking reliable employees who can be trusted to get the job done. Experience in a retail setting or with cash handling would be an asset. Positions will involve working both independently and with others. An easy-going nature and the ability to get along with others are very important as our staff both live and work together. Successful applicants should be excited at the prospect of living and working in a mountain park setting, away from city life.

Job Type: Full-time (35-40 hrs/week), temporary summer employment

There are multiple positions with start dates that range from early May to late June. The positions have end dates of either September 2nd or 16th, 2024. Please confirm your availability and preferred start date in your email.

Work Schedule: Typically 5 shifts per week, usually 6-8 hour shifts, depending on how busy we are. Day and evening shifts are required, and candidates must be available to work any day of the week as days off are typically given midweek.

Wages: \$17.00 per hour, plus 4% vacation pay.

Accommodations: Furnished, shared staff accommodations (with private bedroom) are available in the park. The rent for accommodations is \$150 per month, deducted from your payroll. All utilities and local phone service is included in the deduction. Accommodations are a 10 minute drive from our campers' centre so having your own vehicle is highly recommended. Be aware there is no cell phone service in the park.
